Applications in prescribed format are invited from deserving candidates of Mayurbhanj District for engagement in the following category of Teaching posts on contractual basis for the **Ekalavya Model Residential School, Shyamsundarpur, Bangiriposi and Ekalavya Model Residential School, Karanjia** which are to be functional during the academic year 2018-19 in Mayurbhanj district under ST & SC Development Department.

(1) (A) COMMON ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA :

- be a citizen of India.
- be a permanent resident of Mayurbhanj District
- not have more than one spouse living.
- must be able to read and write Odia. Any one of the following qualifications will be taken into consideration to ascertain this ability of the candidate.
 - He/ she must have passed HSC Exam conducted by Board of Secondary Education, Odisha or an equivalent examination conducted by any other State

- Board or Central Board (like CBSE, ICSE) with Odia as a Language Subject i.e. First/ Second/ Third Language.
- b. He/ she must have passed +2/ Higher Secondary Examination conducted by the Council of Higher Secondary Education, Odisha with Odia as an examinable subject.
 - c. He must have passed Odia examination of HSC/ Tenth standard conducted by BSE, Odisha.
 - d. In case of candidates desirous for Language Teacher post like Hindi Teacher Classical teacher (Sanskrit) passing Odia Examination ME standard conducted by BSE, Odisha may be allowed.
- (e) All candidates must have passed in the Odisha Secondary School Teacher Eligibility Test (OSSTET) conducted by BSE, Odisha in accordance with the guide line framed by the NCTE for the purpose. The candidates who have not passed the OSSTET but otherwise eligible for the post may apply for the post with a condition that they shall have to pass OSSTET within 3 years of joining in the post. They have to furnish an Undertaking to this effect at the time of apply. **Preference will be given to the OSSTET passed candidates.**
- (f) Candidates must specifically indicate the percentage of marks obtained (calculated to the nearest two decimals) in the relevant column of the application. Where percentage of marks is not awarded by the University but only CGPA/OGPA is awarded, the same shall be converted into percentage in terms of conversion norms of University in this regard, besides indicating the CGPA/ OGPA in the application, candidate will have to produce the certificate/ document issued by the University evidencing conversion formula of university & percentage of marks, when called for document verification (Only for Teaching Staffs).
- (g) Candidates must have proficiency in teaching in English Medium and have desirable knowledge of Computer Applications.
- (h) Round of percentage will not be acceptable under any circumstances for consideration for appointment i.e. 49.99% will be treated as less than 50%, likewise 44.99% will be treated as less than 45%.
- (i) The date of declaration of result/ issuance of Mark Sheet shall be deemed to be date of acquiring the qualification and there shall be no relaxation on this account.
- (j) He/she must have successfully completed a 4 years integrated Degree course of Regional College of Education of NCERT in the concerned subject with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ ST/ PH candidates) OR he/she should have a Bachelor's Degree with minimum 50% marks in the concerned subjects/ combination of subjects and in aggregate (45% for SC/ ST/ PH candidates) along with a B.Ed. from an NCTE recognized institution & affiliated to a recognized University. Additionally the electives subjects and languages in the combination of subjects should be as detailed in the educational qualification for specific posts. Regarding Universities/ institutions of outside State, the candidates shall only be eligible for engagement after verification of genuineness of their educational/ training qualification from concerned university/ institution from which they have obtained the degree.

(k) Such outside University/ institution pass out candidates shall have to produce the authenticated proof of equivalency and NCTE recognition in support of their qualification at the time of verification failing which their case will not be entertained.

2. **Age:-** He/she must be below 32 yrs. and above 21 yrs. of age as on 01/01/2018 provided that maximum age limit shall be relaxed by 05 years in case of candidates belong to the ST/ SC/ SEBC & Women candidates. Age shall be relaxed for Ex-Service man as per Odisha Ex-Service Man Rule 1989. In case of PH candidate the upper age shall be relaxed by 10 years as per GA Deptt. Notification no.33068/Gen., dtd.27/10/1989 (Odisha Civil Service, fixation of Upper age limit Rules, 1989) and SEBC Act.

3. **Educational Qualification:-**

a. **Trained Graduate Teacher in Odia-**

1. He/She must have obtained Bachelor Degree Certificate in Odia as Hons, or Pass Subject from recognized university with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and in the concerned subject (45% for SC/ST/PH/SEBC candidates) alongwith a degree in Bachelor in Education (a course prescribed by NCTE) from an institution recognized by BCTE and affiliated to recognized University.

b. **Trained Graduate Teacher in English-** He/She must have obtained bachelor degree certificate in English as Hons. Or pass subject from a recognized university with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and in the concerned subject(45% for SC/ ST/ PH/ SEBC candidates) alongwith a degree in Bachelor in Education (a course prescribed by NCTE) from an institution recognized by BCTE and affiliated to a recognized university.

c. **Trained Graduate Teacher in Mathematics-** He/She must have obtained Bachelor Certificate Degree in Science with Maths as Hons. Or Pass subject with any 2 of the following subjects: Physics, Chemistry, computer Science, Computer Application, Statistics. If he/she has passed Maths as pass subject then he must have Hons either in Physics or in Chemistry from a recognized University with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and in the concerned subject (45% for SC/ ST/ PH/ SEBC candidates) along with a Degree in Bachelor in Education (a course prescribed by NCTE) from an institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized University.

d. **Trained Graduate Teacher in Life Science-** He/She must have obtained bachelor degree certificate in Science with Botany/ Zoology as Hons. Or pass subject from a recognized University with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and in the concerned subjects (45% for SC/ ST/ PH/ SEBC candidates) along with a Degree in Bachelor in Education (a course prescribed by NCTE) from an institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized University.

e. **Trained Graduate Teacher in Physical Science-** He/She must have obtained bachelor degree certificate in Science with Physics/ Chemistry as Hons. Or pass subject from a recognized University with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and in the concerned subjects (45% for SC/ ST/ PH/ SEBC candidates) along with a Degree

in Bachelor in Education (a course prescribed by NCTE) from an institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized University.

- f. **Trained Graduate Teacher in Social Science-** He/She must have obtained bachelor degree certificate in Arts with Honours Subject in any one (01) out of the following three (03) subjects- History, Geography, Political Science, in addition, he/she should have one more elective/ pass subject out of the following 08 subjects: History, Geography, Economics, Political Science, Indian Polity, Indian Economy, Indian Geography and Landmarks in Indian History from a recognized University with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and in the concerned subjects (45% for SC/ ST/ PH/ SEBC candidates) along with a Degree in Bachelor in Education (a course prescribed by NCTE) from an institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized University.

- g. **Trained Graduate Teacher in Sanskrit-**

In pursuance to Resolution No 23399/SME dated 27.10.2014 of School and Mass Education Deptt, the eligibility criteria is as follows **in the following order of preference for providing quality and better education to the students.**

Bachelor Degree with Sanskrit as one of the optional/ Hons. Subject from a recognized University with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and in the concerned subject (45% for SC/ ST/ PH candidates) with Sikshya Shastri (Sanskrit) (a course prescribed by NCTE) from a recognized University/ Institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized University OR Shastri (Sanskrit) with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ ST/ PH / SEBC candidates) from recognized University and Sikshya Shastri (Sanskrit) (a course recognized by NCTE) from an institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized University.

OR

Acharya (Except Jyotishacharya and Ayurvedacharya) or Sahityacharya with minimum 50% marks in aggregate from a recognized University

OR

Bachelor's Degree with Sanskrit as one of the optional/ Hons. Subject with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and in the concerned subject (45% for SC/ ST/ PH / SEBC candidates) and M.A. in Sanskrit with minimum 50% marks in aggregate from a recognized University.

- h. **Trained Graduate Teacher in Hindi-**

In pursuance to Resolution No 23395/SME dated 27.10.2014 of School and Mass Education Deptt, the eligibility criteria is as follows **in the following order of preference for providing quality and better education to the students**

Bachelor's Degree from a Recognised University with Hindi as one of the Hons/elective subject with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and in the concerned subject (45% for SC/ ST/ PH/ SEBC candidates) or with Rastrabhasa Ratna from Rastrabhasa Prachar Samiti, Wardha or with Sastri from Odisha Rastrabhasa Parisada, Puri or with Snataka (Acquired by June, 2005, the date up to which the

temporary recognition has been granted) from Hindi Sikshya Samiti, Odisha, Cuttack or an equivalent Degree from a recognized institution with at least 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ ST/ PH/ SEBC candidates) and Hindi Sikshyan Parangat from Kendriya Hindi Sansthan, Agra/ B.H.Ed. (a course prescribed by NCTE) from a Institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized University/ B.Ed. in Hindi (a course prescribed by NCTE) from Dakhin Bharat Hindi Prachar Sabha, Madras, a institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized University.

OR

Bachelor's Degree with Hindi as one of the optional/ Hons. Subject with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ ST/ PH/ SEBC candidates) and M.A. in Hindi with minimum 50% marks in aggregate from a recognized University.

- i. The candidates should have registered their names either in the Employment Bureau located at Vanivihar, Bhubaneswar/ Jyoti Vihar, Sambalpur/ Bhanja Vihar, Berhampur/ OUAT, Bhubaneswar or in the State Employment Exchange, Bhubaneswar or in any District Employment Exchange, SC/ST and PH candidates should have registered their name in the Special Employment Exchange for SC/ST & PH at Bhubaneswar or in any Employment Exchange located in the concerned Revenue District which he/ she belong to.

4. Reservation:-

The Odisha Reservation of Vacancies (In posts and services for ST&SC) Act, 1975 and the Odisha Reservation of Posts & Services for Socially & Educationally Backward Classes Act, 2008 and the rules made there under and such other principles of the post based reservation as prescribed by the State Government on the land mark judgement of Hon'ble High Court/ Supreme Court, from time to time, shall be followed.

One third of the notified vacancies will be reserved for Women Candidates of respective categories. Similarly 4% will be reserved for Physically Handicapped as per the provision of Section-33 of the "Persons with disabilities" (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation Act), 1% for eminent sports personnel and 3% for Ex-Serviceman.

Instruction contained in SSEPD Deptt. Resolution No.7140/Dtd.05/09/2017 shall be adhered to for (PwDs) candidates.

The PH candidates shall be referred to the Appellate Medical Board constituted by W&CD Department vide Notification No.16430/WCD/Dtd.06/09/2011 for re-examination. Engagement order shall be issued if such candidates found genuine by the Board.

7. Selection Procedure:-

Selection will be made by the District Selection Committee headed by the Collector & District Magistrate, Mayurbhanj, PA,ITDA, Baripada, Dist. Education Officer, Mayurbhanj Inspector of Schools(SSD) Mayurbhanj, District Inspector of Schools(SSD)Mayurbhanj and District Welfare Officer, Mayurbhanj is Member Secretary of the Committee (as per Govt. in ST & SC Development Deptt. Notification No. 3475/TW Dt.13.12.1993).Selection shall be made only on merit i.e. on the basis of percentage of marks obtained by the candidates in different examination, starting from High School Certificate Examination or equivalent up to the minimum qualification required for the post.

After verification Merit List (150%)shall be prepared for each category of candidates on the basis of the percentage of marks secured in H.S.C. Examination(without extra optional if any),BA/B.Com/BSc.(without Ancillary and Foundation courses if any)& B.Ed. Examination in case TG(Arts & Science Teacher)and in case of Sanskrit, Hindi,(without extra optional Ancillary and Foundation courses if any)the percentage of marks secured by a candidate in each qualifying examination.

- (i) In case of two or more candidates secured the same marks the candidate older in age will be placed above in the rank.
- (ii) If there is further tie, the higher percentage of marks secured in training qualification will be taken into account.

(iii) Higher education will not be given any weight age during preparation of merit list in all categories secured.
