18. SABALA SCHEME

(i) Non-Nutrition (IFATab.)

The basic objectives of the scheme are to improve nutritional and health status of girls within the age group of 11-18 years and creating awareness of health, hygiene, nutrition which will control anemia of a future mother.

(ii) PDA (POSITIVE DEVIANCE APPPROACH)

The positive deviance approach scheme has been implemented in 51 AWCs since July-2016, NCCS started in 51 AWCs. The object of the scheme is to improve the nutritional status M.U.W. & S.U.W. age of group of 6 months to 3 years children.
