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

2. The tender must be submitted in sealed cover, the name of the tenderer and name of the work being noted on the cover.
3. No tenderers will be permitted to furnish their tender paper in their own manuscript papers.
4. The work is to be completed in all respects within 8(Eight) calendar months from the date of issue of the work order. Tenderers whose tender is accepted must submit programme of work immediately after issue of work order for approval of the Engineer-in-charge.
5. All tenders received will remain valid for a period of two months (sixty days) from the date of receipt of tenders and validity of tenders can also be extended if agreed to by the tenderer and the department.
6. In case of item rate bid, the rate should be written both in words & figures and unit in words. In case of any discrepancy in rates between words & figures the amounting words will prevail. The Tenderer should show total of each item and grand total of the whole Tender.
7. **In case of percentage rate bid,** the percentage should be quoted accurately in words & Figures. If there is any discrepancy between words and figures, the rates quoted in words shall be taken as correct. If the bidder quotes the percentage without mentioning excess or less and not supported with corresponding amount will be treated as excess. The bidders shall write the percentage in excess or less up to one decimal point only. If the bidder writes the percentage up-to two or more decimal point, the first decimal point shall only be considered without rounding off. The bills for percentage rate tendered shall be prepared at the prevailing estimating rates for individual item only and the percentage of

- excess or less shall be added or subtracted from the gross bill. Vide G.O. No. 8314/2017/1256 (Annexure II).
8. The tenderers shall thoroughly study the technical specifications applicable to contract under the document which form part of the agreement to be entered into by the accepted tenderer and detail of special relevant specification and drawings which are available to the tenderers at date that plans and specifications have not been sent by the tenderers.
 9. Every tenderer is expected to quote his rates for the work. He should also inspect the quarries and roads and satisfy himself about the quality and availability of materials. He should complete with all relevant specifications. Consideration of availability of materials at quarry should not be misjudged and he should quote accordingly.
 10. Samples of stone, metal, etc. & bricks etc. to be used in the work of quarry & brick kiln should be marked with initials of the Block Development Officer. The requirement for the work should be clearly stated.
 11. It must be clearly understood that the tenderer is responsible for the correctness and completeness of the bill to be taken at site of work.
 12. Each tenderer except one having the prescribed percentage of work with the Block Development Officer (BDO) must pay a sum of _____ Rupees as earnest money only along with tender.  16. Schedule of quantity & rates implies the IFI rates. It is to be understood that the tenderer is liable to accept a percentage of completeness of the work and that this percentage is to be deducted from the bill amount worth in the bill. The security deposit shall be held in an escrow account according to the prescribed procedure. Failure to comply with the above conditions shall result in the security deposit being forfeited to the Government. No tender shall be finally accepted until the security deposit is deposited. 22. The contractor shall be liable to indemnify the department for payment of compensation under Workmen Compensation Act, VI of 1923 on account of the workmen employed on the contract and full amount of compensation paid will be recovered from the contractor.
23. The tenderer shall be free to avail of the Fair wage clause as introduced by Government of Orissa, Workmen Compensation Act, VI of 1923 and No. 12 of 1952 (as amended) from time to time.

24. In case of any default on the laborer's part in respect of employment or less payment, the contractor's latest minimum wages order shall be in force. The Block Development Office will have the right to investigate and if found to be in default, he may restore status quo ante from the date of default or take any other action directly under labour law. The decision of the Block Development Office is final and binding on the contractor.
25. The tenderers shall provide for all contingencies necessitated by the work to be done within the following items:
 - a) Rental of public utility vehicles of material, supply of fuel, ferry charges, cartage charges and other costs including temporary labour, including electric connection, cost of sealing road, maintenance of road and its maintenance required by the tenderer for execution of main work for purpose of the work. Government will however be liable for temporary overheads to be provided by Government.
 - b) Labour camp or quarters to a suitable standard in such arrangement as to facilitate the production of the work.
 - c) Suitable water supply for supply pipe water supply within labour camp or quarters.
 - d) Fees of courts as levied by the municipal, cantonment or other authorities.
 - e) Suitable equipment for handling apparatus for heavy machinery operations.
 - f) Suitable fencing and other measures including guard rails and signals where necessary at work sites and premises in order to prevent employees from accidents.
 - g) Compensation for any injury or suit for injury or death of any person or persons who become permanently or partially disabled as a result of any accident due to neglect of any of the provisions of the Workmen Compensation Act.
 - h) The tenderer shall provide adequate lighting wherever necessary at the work site.
26. After the work is done, the surplus material, tools, work, or implements, such as rats, mixing pans, etc. and all materials remaining on the site and premises should be included in the bill.
27. No payment shall be made for bench marking, leveling, or grading, or any other work. The rates for work shall include of material, tools, materials and labour.


