



Sealed tenders are invited by the undersigned for disposal of the Govt. vehicle bearing No. OR-11D-9999 (Bolero) in the office of the Collector & District Magistrate, Mayurbhanj through auction sale. The upset price of the vehicle has been fixed to Rs. 60,000/-. The auction sale shall be conducted as per following terms and conditions.

- (1) The intending tender parties may submit their offer in a plain paper mentioning following criteria.
 - (a) Name and detail address of the Auction holder.
 - (b) Amount and details of EMD deposited.
 - (c) Amount of Price offered.
 - (d) Signature.
- (2) The sealed cover super scribed as "Sealed tender paper of condemned vehicle bearing No.OR-11D-9999" should be sent addressing to the Additional District Magistrate, Mayurbhanj At/ Po- Baripada, Dist.-Mayurbhanj, Pin-757001 by registered post / speed post or to be dropped in the sealed tender box kept in the office chamber of the ADM, Mayurbhanj before 12.30 PM of 06.04.21 2021. The entire tender received within schedule time shall be opened at 3.30 PM on the same day in presence of bidder or their authorized agent in the chamber of the ADM, Mayurbhanj.
- (3) The vehicle shall be kept in the residence of Collector, Mayurbhanj which may be inspected during office hour on any working day.
- (4) The competitors shall be required to deposit Earnest Money amounting to Rs.6,000/- (Rupees Six Thousand)only in shape of Bank Draft in favour of Nizarat Officer, Collectorate, Mayurbhanj payable at SBI, Baripada which shall be refunded on submission of application after disposal of the vehicle.
- (5) The highest offered price above the up set price may be approved by the competent Authority. The successful bidder shall to deposit full amount within 3 days of opening of tenders.
- (6) On failure to make payment as aforesaid, the Earnest money shall be forfeited and the vehicle may put to fresh tender or the second highest bidder above upset price may be considered.
- (7) The vehicle shall not be delivered to the party until full payment is made and compliance with the requisite formalities. Tools, equipments and spare parts shall not be delivered with the vehicle.
- (8) The successful bidder shall take steps for change of ownership in his/her favour consulting the local Road Transport Authority and compliance of all necessary official formalities.
- (9) The undersigned reserves the right to accept or reject any or all conditions mentioned above without assigning any reason thereof.
- (10) Decision of the undersigned is final in case of any dispute.
